


2014 Installation of Officers

Message from the East

Greetings Brethren,

I would like to take this opportunity to let you know a little bit about me. My wife, Katie, and I live in Union Township, which is where I have lived all of my life. I am a graduate of both Xavier University and NKU Salmon P. Chase College of Law. As many of you know, I am third generation member of J.B. Covert. My late grandfather, Brother Clay Campbell, was a fifty-year member. My father, Worshipful Brother Ron Campbell, was Master of our Lodge in 1999. I have been fortunate to benefit from their experience and wisdom. I hope that I can serve you as well as they have taught me.

I have spent a great deal of time thinking about what my one and only year as Master should mean. I began thinking about all of duties that we as Masons are bound to perform. Anyone who knew Kyle, or my grandfather for the matter, knew a man who worked hard but always remembered to enjoy life. May we strive to imitate their examples. That is my goal for each of you and for our Lodge as a whole.




Secretary's Notes
